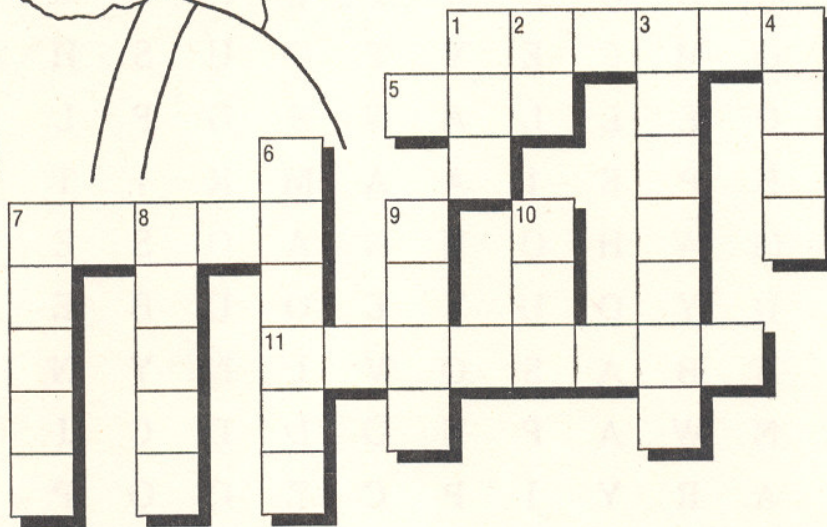


The Messiah
